

NEW LICENSEE CE AND PRODUCER LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011

A new licensee requiring Continuing Education (CE) is an individual issued a qualification for any one of the following on/after **January 1, 2010**: LIFE, VARIABLE, ACCIDENT & HEALTH/S, PROPERTY, CASUALTY AND PERSONAL LINES.

CE REQUIREMENTS **DO NOT APPLY TO LIMITED LINES OF AUTHORITY: CROP, CREDIT, ETC**). All newly licensed producers must complete 24 hours of CE and pay the producer license renewal fee beginning with the first year of compliance. The chart below is designed to assist newly licensed producers with determining the requirements for Continuing Education (CE) compliance and when producer biennial licensing fees are due to be paid.

The following charts will serve as a guide, based on birth month/birth year for producers to determine when their CE requirements and \$25 producer license renewal fee is due to be paid. All producers newly licensed January 1, 2010 and after must use the chart below to meet CE and license renewal requirements.

To use this chart, find the year that you were licensed, and scroll to the right to locate your birth month. Depending on your birth year (odd or even year), you must complete CE and licensing requirements before the 31st day of your birth month. Four examples have been provided for a clearer understanding.
